SENIOR CLASS NOTES

Cooperation has been the keynote of the Class of 1940, and as a result it has endeavored to contribute its share of school spirit, and in every way possible to further the progress of Catholic education.

Shortly after school opened in September, the seniors chose their class officers, and not long after the first edition of the school paper was issued under the supervision of the staff which was elected the year before to edit the junior edition of the paper. This year's subscription list reached a new high following a drive to increase circulation.

Seeing a need for funds in the athletic treasury, the seniors sold Christmas cards and were able to place about half a hundred dollars in the care of the Athletic Association.

Wishing to further social activities, and hoping to establish the custom of an annual dance for the high school, the seniors sponsored a "Golddiggers" dance in the fall.

The annual bazaar was undertaken with the usual spirit of helpfulness, and consequently the records of other classes were reached and even bettered.

As a lasting memorial to the school, the Class of 1940 donated the trophy case which stands in the main hall of the school. Going further, they helped to fill the case with trophies by merit of their representatives on the football, basketball, and softball teams. For the first time in our athletic history a St. Mary basketball team competed in the semi-finals at Westerville, and a senior, Raymond Robbins, was elected all-tournament second team captain.

This year's graduating class will be the largest in the history of the school, rivaled only by one former class which numbered four less than forty-four which is the number in the class of 1940.

With courage they face the future, knowing full well that, though worldly gain may lure them on, their first duty is fidelity to God's law, and loyalty to their country. May each day of their lives, as were their school days, be dedicated to the honor and glory of God, and to the patron of this school, Mary, the Mother of God.
